March is Colorectal Cancer Awareness Month!

Colorectal cancer screening saves lives. The risk of developing colorectal cancer increases with advancing age. More than 90% of cases occur in people aged 50 or older. If everyone aged 50 years old or older were screened regularly, up to 60% of deaths from this cancer could be avoided.

Talk with your doctor about which test or tests are best for you.

Colonoscopy (every 10 years)

Fecal Occult Blood Test (FOBT) (every year)

Flexible Sigmoidoscopy (every 5 years)

Double-Contrast Barium Enema (every 5 years)
